These membership benefits apply for your patrons when Mount Washington State Park is open (Approximate Mid-May to Mid-October). Please send all questions and inquiries to Drew Bush at dbush@mountwashington.org. Membership Cost: \$100

For Mount Washington Observatory:

- Free weather station tour for family with two adults and kids (age 17 and under). No tours on Wednesdays.
- We will email you one code for your patrons to use for the entire season, and patrons can book in advance here: <https://mountwashington.org/education/weather-station-tours/>
- Patrons can also bring the Library Pass to Extreme Mount Washington Museum on the summit (lower level), though space could be limited and advance reservations are recommended.
- Free access to Gladys Brooks Memorial Library at our North Conway office all year (appointments by request).

For Mt. Washington Auto Road:

- One passenger in each "Drive Yourself" vehicle rides free.
- Bring printed or digital Library Pass to ticket office at base of Mt. Washington Auto Road to redeem. *Please Note: This is not the toll house at the base of the mountain, patrons should bring it across the street to the big lodge building to receive this deal.*

For Mount Washington Cog Railway:

- Buy 1 Adult Ticket and get 1 Adult Ticket free.
- Month of June 2026 Monday-to-Friday trains only.
